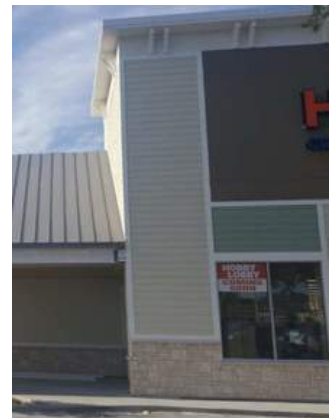

1. Get Multiple Bids, Then Compare

2. Watch Out For Change Orders
Insist on detailed specification and drawings for the work to be performed. Vague work scopes = trouble for homeowners and invites costly change orders and ballooning cost.
